CEMETERY COMMITTEE - We need to have a Cemetery Committee meeting - so I would like to call one for Monday evening, **April 14th, at 7 PM in the Priory Conference Room**. If you have been on this committee in the past, or wish to serve on it now, please make every effort to attend this meeting. It will last about an hour.

K of C BREAKFAST - the final Knights of Columbus breakfast for this year will take place next weekend, on Palm Sunday. Service will begin at 8 AM and run through 10:30 AM. Same delicious menu of scrambled eggs, homemade biscuits and sausage gravy, juice and coffee - all for a free-will donation. LENT - As we have done over the past few years, the Sacrament of Reconciliation will be available not only on Saturday afternoons from 3 - 3:45 PM or by appointment, but also on Wednesday evenings, from 6 - 7 PM. Since St. Boniface church is used before 7 PM as a gathering place for our CCD program, and since I must be ready to receive the high school CCD students right at 7 PM, Confession on Wednesday evenings will be in the parish office at the Priory. Please, if you do come for Confession on Wednesday evenings, please come closer to 6 PM rather than right before 7 PM. Thanks for your understanding and sensitivity to this scheduling issue. **On the tables at the entrance of each church are Rice Bowl kits for use throughout the season. Please take one per family. Collection bins for the Rice Bowls will be set out from Palm Sunday weekend throughout Holy Week and on Easter.** Good Friday (April 18th) is the next universal day of Fast and Abstinence in the Church. On Fridays during Lent, we are asked to abstain from meat, and to make a sacrificial offering for those in need (the Rice Bowls!!!) **Stations of the Cross will be held on Friday evenings at 7 PM - at St. Therese on April 11th.** Our communal Reconciliation Service will be next weekend, Palm Sunday evening, April 13th, at 5 PM. **I will be looking for volunteers who would be willing to have their feet washed at the Holy Thursday Mass at each parish. If you are willing to participate in this ritual, please let me know!** More information will be posted as we move through the season of Lent.
