As I mentioned in last week's Bulletin, his appeal is part of our Archdiocese's participation in the Missionary Cooperative Plan (the Propagation of the Faith), which is an annual requirement for all parishes in the Archdiocese. There will be a second collection following Communion this weekend for this purpose. There are no special envelopes in your packages for this - but they are available on the entrance tables, and ushers will gladly distribute them during the regular collection time.
