Please prayerfully consider how to best make your sacrificial offering this year. For information sake, our established target goals are **\$6,863.00 for St. Boniface** (\$6,364.00 last year); and **\$3,269.00 for St. Therese** (\$3,321.00 last year). As of last Wednesday, there were responses from 14% of the St. Boniface parishioners (15 families), who have pledged \$2,304.00, or 34% of the target, with an average gift of \$154.00. There were responses from 24% of the St. Therese parishioners (11 families), who have pledged \$1,425.00, or 44% of the target, with an average gift of \$130.00. **Thank you!**
