**Blessed Titus Brandsma, O. Carm.**  
**Feastday - July 27th**

A Dutch Carmelite priest, Titus Brandsma was a renowned professor, journalist, and scholar at the time of the Nazi occupation of Holland in 1940. Labeled a "most dangerous man" by the Nazis, he was arrested and eventually sent to Dachau, where, 75 years ago, on July 26, 1942 he was executed by lethal injection and his ashes were buried in Dachau's Grave of Unknown Thousands.

Titus sought to live his whole life in intimate union with God. "God should dwell in us, be born again in us," he wrote. "This presence must radiate our whole being and conduct."

We give thanks to God when we call Titus Blessed, and pray for the cause of his canonization.
