ARCHBISHOP'S CALL TO SHARE



Congratulations to both parishes for surpassing the target goal, and I share my gratitude as well as Archbishop Naumann's for your generosity! As of last Wednesday, March 18th, your generosity is reflected in the following figures: St. Boniface: 64 people or families (58% of the parish) have contributed or pledged \$7,634.00 (111% of our target goal), with an average gift or pledge of \$122.00. St. Therese: 31 people or families (67% of the parish), have contributed or pledged \$6,530.00 (200% of our target goal), with an average gift or pledge of \$211.00. 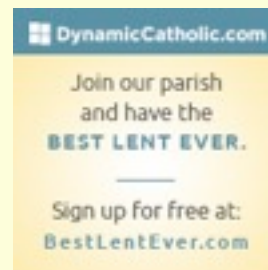
