It is our hope that every Carmelite Parish, School, and all of our institutions and those who are part of the Carmelite family through our ministries, will learn this beautiful hymn and pray it with us in song as frequently as possible. You will find laminated copies of this "new" version in the pews this weekend, and we will learn it throughout the month of May by singing it throughout the month. Though I am not much of a proponent for using Latin in the liturgy, the Latin refrain flows a bit more easily, so I would like to use that, at least initially. Then, after we all become more comfortable with the melody, we can use both the English as well as the Latin, at least on occasion. Would you please be so kind as to place the laminated copies into the front cover of the Missalettes after we try the hymn this weekend? Then they will be handy for regular use. Thanks, and I hope you enjoy this beautiful hymn and the special relationship you share with all of the Carmelites - as we are so richly blessed by being a part of your lives. And may Mary, Our Lady of Mount Carmel, continue to watch over us all!
