**LENT HAS BEGUN!** - You will find many suggestions for fasting and abstinence contained in the Rice Bowl kits that are still available. I would ask that **EVERY family take a Rice Bowl Kit home, and use it faithfully during Lent.** The Sacrament of Reconciliation will be available at all parishes throughout the Archdiocese on Wednesday evenings, from 6 - 7 PM. Here at St. Boniface and St. Therese - I will be available at the Priory during that time period. Please just come to the front door of the Priory and ring the bell. Reconciliation is also available on Saturday afternoons from 3 - 3:45 PM in the Sacristy at St. Boniface. **Stations of the Cross will be prayed at 7:00 PM on Friday evenings at St. Boniface on March 17th, and 31st; and at St. Therese on March 24th, and April 7th.** Finally, local Knights of Columbus Fish Fries will be on Friday evenings in Garnett on March 17th, and 31st; and at Greeley on March 24th, and April 7th. **A fruitful and holy Lenten season to you all!**
