**MEMORIAL DAY MASS** - will be celebrated in the church proper, at **8:15 AM** on Memorial Day only! This will allow those who wish to begin the holiday with Mass to also be able to make it down to St. Boniface Cemetery for the Memorial Day service there which is scheduled to begin at 9:00 AM.

**ST. BONIFACE PARISH COUNCIL** - meet next Sunday, June 3rd, after the 9 AM Mass in the Priory dining room.

**OBERRAMMERGAU 2020** - The world-famous Passion Play of Oberammergau, Germany, will be performed again in 2020. It has been performed every ten years, consistently, since 1634. There are several pilgrimage packages that are being offered, between mid-May through the end of September, 2020, that include airfare from New York, accommodations, Play Tickets, most meals, Professional Escorted Sightseeing, and all service charges - and the prices run from \$3,369.00 - \$4,699.00, and the length of the trips are from 9 days through 12 days, depending on the particular pilgrimage chosen (all of them include Oberammergau combined with other locations, such as Austria, Switzerland, Italy, Poland, Hungary, Czech Republic, France, Greece and the Holy Land). If you feel you might be interested in going and planning such a pilgrimage, please call me or drop me an e-mail. We will then have a planning meeting on Monday evening, June 11th, at St. Boniface Parish Hall, at 7:00 PM to choose a package and begin promotion of the pilgrimage.

**RECORD UPDATING** - A regular summer project is the updating of the records for both parishes. If you would like me to check if I have your correct information, **or if there have been changes in your information** within the past year or so, please call, send me a note through the Post Office, or via e-mail. **Any changes would be most helpful**, such as name changes, deletions, address changes, dropping of phone land-lines, adding of cell phone numbers, addition or deletion of e-mail addresses, church and date of Baptisms of all family members - if available, and letting me know of **any interest you may have in participating in any of the parish ministries.**

**TEENS LOOKING FOR SOME SUMMER WORK?** There are a number of odd jobs that need to be taken care of throughout the summer, and the rest of the year, in both parishes. If you would like to have your name included on a list of paid helpers for occasional projects, please send me your name, phone number, and e-mail address. Any participation in these projects will need to have parental permission.

**PRESCRIPTION BOTTLE CAPS** - Auburn Pharmacies are now also accepting the caps from both the green and the blue prescription bottles. There are collection boxes for these around town and at the back of each church.

**EVERY LITTLE BIT HELPS!** - Several parishioners are quietly working in the background, implementing fund-raising activities and events that really do pay off for all of us! At the Garnett Square Fair, \$810.00 was raised for the New Hall Fund through the sales of donated Longaberger Baskets; The Carmelite **STARS** received grant money of \$762.00 because we have had a number of adults participate in the Youth Ministry Workshops throughout the year; Ink Cartridge recycling helps us financially as well as environmentally; Prescription Bottle Caps have begun to pay off nicely; and Best Choice label collections are an easy way to participate in fund-raising. Please keep these efforts in mind, and know that your participation DOES make a difference! Also, **during this time of Family Reunions, consider handing out a supply of New Hall Fund envelopes to relatives who may have moved from the area, or put out a collection bin for Cemetery Upkeep.** You might be quite surprised at how responsive people might be if you encourage them! If you'd like a supply of envelopes, please let me know!

**YOUTH OUTREACH** - There are two programs for our youth (and our families) that are still off in the distance - but to make you all aware for planning purposes, I'll continue to mention them now. The Rural Youth Summer tour will be held on August 12th in Horton; and on August 19th here in Scipio. The theme this year is: **Perfectly Imperfect**. The Rural Catholic Youth Conference will be in Topeka from November 17th - 18th, and the theme is: **Crafted and Worthy**. There are flyers on the Bulletin Boards with information - but mark your calendars now!

**LITURGICAL MINISTRIES** - Both parishes would greatly benefit if additional people would be willing to add their names and their gifts to the roster of Liturgical Ministers: Servers, Lectors, and Extraordinary Ministers of the Eucharist, Singers, Musicians (of **any** musical instruments), and collection counters would certainly enhance our Liturgy - and would offer a much deserved break to many faithful members who have been offering their services for years.
